

Nazis Threaten Batista In Cuba With a Shelling

HAVANA, May 4—A threat against President Fulgencio Batista, implying that his residence might be shelled by Axis warcraft, was broadcast by the Berlin radio last night, according to a bulletin issued by the Presidential Palace today. The Nazi broadcast retorted to a reference by President Batista to the Axis powers as "hyenas."

"Some Chiefs of State of Latin-American republics used May 1 to incite their workers against the Germans," the Berlin radio was quoted as saying.

"President Batista of Cuba, one of the best educated and closest to War Promoter Roosevelt, said we Germans were harmful animals that must be attacked in our dens.

"Friend Batista: Remember, you live only a few meters from the waterfront."
