

CUBAN FLEES TO HONDURAS.

Senator, Sought on Murder Charge After Duel, Reported in Tegucigalpa.

HAVANA, July 24.—Senator Modesto Maidique, a fugitive from justice as a result of investigation of the death of Senator Zayas Bazan in a duel, today was reported to have reached Tegucigalpa, Honduras, where he is likely to remain, since this country has no treaty under which he is extraditable.

The Senate has waived the immunity of Senator Maidique, who is now charged with murder.

Although a police cordon has been maintained around Senator Maidique's residence since the date of the duel, he was able to slip through the lines and flee Cuba on a private yacht.
