

CUBA COMMUNISTS MARCH

Assure Grau of Support, Bid Him Oust 'Reactionaries'

HAVANA, July 8—Several thousand workers marched to the Presidential Palace this morning to assure President Ramon Grau San Martin of their support and to urge him to oust so-called reactionaries from his Government. The demonstration was organized by the Communist party and the Confederation of Cuban Workers, controlled by the Communists.

The Communists recently declared "open warfare" against the Republican party, headed by the Minister of State, Dr. Gustavo Cuervo Rubio, and have been attempting to split the coalition between the Republicans and Autenticos that elected Dr. Grau in order to ally themselves with Dr. Grau's party for the 1946 elections.
