

# *Professor Slain by Gunmen in Uptown Havana*

Havana, Aug. 15.—Dr. Ramiro Valdes Daussa, professor of Havana university and a well-known revolutionist, was killed tonight by men who pulled their car alongside his automobile and opened fire.

Five bullets hit him.

Valdes Daussa was a prominent revolutionist in the struggle to overthrow the regime of the late President Gerardo Machado in 1933.

The assassination occurred in uptown Havana, at Neptuno and Mazon streets.

Two students were arrested, one gravely wounded. Another, who police said tried to escape from the assassin's car, fired several shots at two soldiers before they took him into custody.

A third occupant of the death car was unaccounted for.
