The following is a list of all Cuban exiles who have been invited to dialogue with the Cuban government.

- 1) RAUL ACOSTA RUBIO - Cuban newspaperman presently residing in Caracas, Venezuela.
- 2) RAMON AGUERO GRAU - son of POLITA GRAU ALCINA, who is presently in jail in Cuba and is the niece of one-time Cuban President RAMON GRAU SAN MARTIN.
- 3) WILFREDO ALLEN - Director of a local drug rehabilitation program.
- 4) RAUL ALZAGA - unknown affiliation. Resides in Puerto Rico.
- 5) GUILLERMO ARIAS - Catholic priest. He is a professor at Belen Prep School in Miami. He was one of the members of the commission which traveled to Cuba on 20 October 1978.
- 6) CECILIO ARRASTRIA - member of the Christian Pro Justice and Liberty Group out of Atlanta, Georgia.
- 7) BERNARDO BENES - Vice-President of the Continental Bank of Miami.
- 8) MIGUEL BETANCOURT - President of the Committee Pro-reunification of the Cuban Families.
- 9) HEUBERTO CLEMS - Ex-Cuban consul who served in Jamaica until 1960.
- 10) TONY COSTALES - member of a local workers union.
- 11) MANUEL DE DIOS UNANUE - newspaperman for the El Diario-La Prensa of New York. He is representing himself while in Cuba.
- 12) VICENTE DOPICO - member of the group AREITO.
- 13) MANUEL ESPINOSA - Pastor of the Reformed Evangelical Christian Church of Hialeah.

- 14) OSVALDO ESTIVIL - member of the movement UNITED CUBAN ARTISTS.
- 15) CARMEN FRANCO - unknown affiliation.
- 16) EDUARDO GARCIA MOURE - leader of workers union in Caracas, Venezuela.
- 17) ERNESTO GARCIA RUBIO - member of Our Lady of the Divine Providence Church in Miami.
- 18) FRANCISCO GONZALEZ - President of the National Union of Cuban Americans.
- 19) MIGUEL GONZALEZ PANDO - Director of Tricultural Bilingual Program at Florida International University, and member of 2506 BRIGADE.
- 20) REINAL GONZALEZ - ex-political prisoner and member of commission which traveled to Cuba on 20 October 1978.
- 21) JOSEPH HERNANDEZ - member of the CIVIC CHRISTIAN MOVEMENT of Hialeah.
- 22) JOSE HERRERA - Unknown affiliation.
- 23) MARIA CRISTINA HERRERA - Director of the Institute of Cuban Students of Miami, and professor at Miami-Dade Junior College.
- 24) FELIPE JIMENEZ - unknown affiliation.
- 25) OFELIA LOPEZ - member of CIVIC CHRISTIAN MOVEMENT, Los Angeles, California.
- 26) RAUL LORENZO - writer from Caracas, Venezuela.
- 27) CRISTO MADRUGA - unknown affiliation.
- 28) RAUL MARCOS CORREA - leader of a local transport union.
- 29) FERNANDO MENA - member of the Committee for Reunification of the Cuban Family.
- 30) GERARDO MORENO - businessman for Master K.

- 32) ENRIQUE OSLE - Catholic priest. Resides in Puerto Rico. Ex-assistant of Catholic Workers Youth of Cuba.
