THE COURT: Why would you need a firearms expert in a case of this nature? He is not charged with possession of a specific weapon. He is charged with possession of a firearm by a convicted felon.

MR. RASHKIND: We need to have Mr. Keller here from probation and parole. It is not a gun that you can test operability on just like everyday.

THE COURT: That would be beneficial to the defendant.

MR. HORTON: They know this gun was registered

with the Department of Public Safety. It was purchased from a Tampa gun shop and it has been registered with them and they have the receipts on them. They have had those so there is no reason for them to delay this because they are saying it looks like something else. They permitted the Tamiami Gun Shop to sell it. They sold it to another person, not the defendant and it was registered with the Public Safety Department and has been at all times and they have observed this gun before because it was used by the security in connection with the Perrona Diesel Corporation.

THE COURT: I will grant them a continuance.

It is up for hearing or discharge.
