I have the honor to report that by Cuban Army General Order No. 233 of November 25, 1946, the name of the former American airbase was changed from Batista Field to Aeropuerto Comandante Manuel S. Perez Alfonso.

According to information obtained from the Military Air Attaché, Major Manuel S. PEREZ Alfonso, Chief of the Cuban Air Corps in 1940-41, was killed in an airplane accident on December 23, 1941.

Although Colonel Camilo Gonzalez CHAVEZ, present Chief of the Cuban Air Corps, stated that the change in name was effected because according to Cuban law no Government building, airfield, etc., may be named for a living Cuban, it is believed that the underlying reason is that a different political party is now in office in Cuba.
