An organizing committee representing the Rotary Club, the Lions Club, the Good Neighbor Foundation, the National Association of Sugar Mill Owners, the Association of Sugar Cane Growers, the Association of Industrialists, and the Cuban Chamber of Commerce have announced that they will sponsor a public ceremony to be held on February 20 as a reaffirmation of Cuban-American friendship.
