

Gentlemen:

The receipt is acknowledged of your letter of November 11, 1953 in which you state that you are endeavoring to communicate with Dr. Aureliano Sanchoz Arango, believed to be the former Minister of Education of Cuba.

Dr. Aureliano Sanchez Arango was Minister of Education and later Minister of State of Cuba during the Administration of Dr. Carlos Prio Socarras. Shortly after General Fulgencio Batista overthrew the government of Dr. Prio in a military coup d'état on March 10, 1952, Dr. Sanchez Arango took asylum in the Embassy of Mexico in Habana and was permitted to leave Cuba. Subsequently he has been reported to have been in the United States. Mexico, and certain Caribbean islands. The Department of State has no information concerning his present address.
