Subject : Investigation of Cuban Revolutionary Activities

1. Acting upon information received from a confidential informant, Deputy Longbottom and I went to 1240 SW 19 St., Miami. The building is a private home in a residential area. Questioned neighbors and learned that a large number of Cubans have been seen entering and leaving the premises and that many different persons appear to live there. They state that some persons, mostly men come for a short time and are then replaced by others.

2. At 11 am on July 2nd, we went to the house and requested permission to search the premises and speak to persons residing there. Permission was granted and a search disclosed no contraband except a .45 cal. automatic Colt pistol marked property of the U. S. Army. This was seized and a copy of the receipt is attached to this file.

3. Activities at the home, owned by Angel Cofino, were said to be unusual because Mr. Cofino offers temporary residence to Cubans arriving in this country. It appears that there is a business office of some type in one room and that approximately twelve persons were residing on the premises at the time of our visit.
