SUBJECT: Alleged Cuban Revolutionary Activities

On date indicated above, Detectives STONE, FOLLIARD, TARABOCHIA and myself, along with Detective CHARLES PARKER, City of Miami Intelligence Squad, proceeded to 3180 S. W. 6th Street in reference to information received from an informant. Information was that there was some unusual activity going on at the aforementioned location; the possibility of contraband arms being present was foremost in the information.

Upon our arrival we found that that residence was leased to EVARISTO R. GONZALES. Also present at our arrival was MIGUEL ANGEL HIGUERA BASTA , of 54 N. W. 33rd Avenue, PRUDENCIO DUERIAS y ROBERT, of 4355 West Flagler.

Mr. GONZALES allowed us to search the residence, and the search was with negative results for any contraband arms.

At the scene were three autos; their description as follows: 1953 Chevrolet, four-door sedan, 1959 Florida 1-93829, color green; 1959 Chevrolet, four-door sedan, color light green, 1959 Florida 1W-41051; and a 1953 Buick, two-door sedan, color blue and white, 1959 Florida 1W-134177.

Investigation suspended pending further information.
