- 1. At approximately 9 p.m., this date, the Detective Division Complaint Desk received a telephone call from Doctors' Hospital, Coral Gables, reporting that the Cuban Consul, ALONSO HIDALGO, had just been admitted in critical condition from assault injuries.
- 2. Detective P. THIBEDEAU, Homicide car 816, was immediately dispatched to the hospital and Lt. M. HILL, physical offense supervisor, was notified at home. Detective THIBEDEAU reported that upon arrival he contacted a Dr. HERNANDEZ who identified himself as a friend of the victim. HERNANDEZ stated HIDALGO was admitted in "serious condition from shock," but that "now he had recovered somewhat and is now in fair condition." He further stated that the injuries were received in a fight in the City of Miami.
- 3. The city complaint desk was notified of this incident and was requested to dispatch a car to handle complaint as it occurred in the city. They later phoned back and stated they were aware of incident and that HIDALGO was arrested and booked earlier. Their attention was directed to possibility another attack after release might have occurred because of a serious condition. They were further requested to provide me with the phone number of City Intelligence Chief, CAPT. NAPIER, in order to make a personal notification. They advised this would not be necessary as an intelligence squad detective was aware of the call.
