Personally appeared DETECTIVE S.B. BILLBROUGH, METROPOLITAN PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT, DADE CO. FLA. who, being first duly cautioned and sworn according

to law, upon his oath deposes and says, THAT HE, S.B. BILLBROUGH, THE AFFIANT, HAS RECEIVED RELIABLE INFORMATION FROM A CONFIDENTIAL INFORMANT THAT EXPLOSIVES, MACHINE GUNS, RIFLES, AMMUNITION AND OTHER CONTRABAND AND WEAPONS ARE ILLEGALLY STORED AND POSSESSED AT A CERTAIN PREMISES DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

A CBS SINGLE FAMILY ONE STORY RESIDENCE BUILDING, PAINTED LIGHT GREY WITH WHITE TRIM, GRAVEL ROOF, AND WITH THE APPEARANCE OF RECENTLY BEING CONSTRUCTED; WITH A SILVER COLORED MAILBOX CONTAINING NO NAME IN FRONT, LOCATED AT 5040 S.W. WESTWOOD LAKE DR., IN A SECTION KNOWN AS WESTWOOD LAKE. THE BUILDING IS ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE STREET, THE SECOND HOME NORTH OF S.W. 51 TERR. AND OPPOSITE A ROCKPIT BEING CONSTRUCTED INTO A LAKE, IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF DADE COUNTY.

THE AFFIANT FURTHER STATES THAT THIS CONFIDENTIAL INFORMANT HAS OBSERVED AND VISITED THE PREMISES ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS AND HAS OBSERVED WOODEN CRATES AND CASES MARKED "EXPLOSIVES" AND "ARMS" AND THAT HE HAS ACTUALLY OBSERVED THE EXPLOSIVES, MACHINE GUNS, RIFLES, AMMUNITION AND OTHER CONTRABAND AND WEAPONS ILLEGALLY STORED AND POSSESSED THERE.

AND THAT HE THEREFORE HAS good reason to believe, and does believe, that the aforesaid premises are being unlawfully used for the purpose of THE ILLEGAL STORAGE OF EXPLOSIVES, MACHINE GUNS, RIFLES, AMMUNITION AND OTHER CONTRABAND AND WEAPONS CONTARY TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATUE OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA.

WHEREFORE, affiant prays that a search warrant be issued according to law.
