SUBJECT: ALLEGED CUBAN REVOLUTIONISTS

Received information from <u>Mr. and Mrs. Veverka</u> that they received information from <u>Juneita Salas</u>, Puerto Rican, who lives at 6480 N.W. 3 Street, the Junction of Tamiami Canal Road.

They gave the name of a man named <u>Orestes</u> <u>Lopez Cruz</u> as a Cuban Rebel leader. He resides at 8430 N.W. 33 Avenue where Cuban meetings have been held. He has a green and cream colored Chevrolet with a '58 Florida license #1-19235. This is about a '55 model Chevrolet. Lopez is connected in some way with the makers and publishers of the "Sierra Maestra" Cuban newspaper.

A sister of sister-in-law of Lopez's works at the Dade Blood Testing Center.

The Rebles are alleged to be selling bonds here in Miami to finance the Cubans with arms to be sent to Cuba.
