• Federal Pro-Castro Subsidies. Antonio de la Cova of the Selous Foundation's Institute for U.S.-Cuba Relations recently charged that U.S. tax dollars are being used in a propaganda drive to normalize relations with Fidel Castro's Cuba. In a paper entitled "Academic Espionage," Cova states that the U.S. State Department has given half a million dollars to a group of Cuban-American university professors who have strong ties to front groups of Castro's secret police. Most of the group of 17 profes-sors, who are based out of Florida Inter-

national University, have publicly declared that the United States should end its embargo against Cuba and normalize trade relations with that nation. The government-funded pro-Castro propaganda commission is expected to publish its fihal report, titled Cuba in Transition, in June 1993.
