

DEATH OF GEN. J. E. FARNUM.—The New York papers announce the death, in that city, on Monday, of Gen. J. Egbert Farnum, in the forty-sixth year of his age. Gen. Farnum was a native of New Jersey, but spent his early years at Fottleville, Pa. During the Mexican war he joined the first regiment of Pennsylvania volunteers, and served with it till the restoration of peace. Subsequently he figured in the Walker Nicaragua expedition, and during the rebellion he achieved the rank of major general. Recently he held an office in the custom-house.
