On arrival at Rio, the American Consul, after an examination of the affair, ordered the arrest of the mate. Before being taken ashore be made an unsuccessful attempt at suicide. The body of Caps. Frazer is to be sent home in the ship Union, about leaving for New York. The mate's name is Sylvanus M. Sonney.
