

## Central American Affairs.

ASPENWALT, Oct. 20.

(Per Star of the West.) The government of Costa Rica and Nicaragua are raising every force possible. Col. Cauty, of the Costa Rica Army, was blockading the river San Juan, at Castillo for the purpose of taking that fort. His reason for so doing, as posted at Grey's own, was, that as there is, at present, no recognized government at Nicaragua, he wishes to occupy the above fort so as to prevent any further invasion of the filibusters. The river boats are all above San Carlos.
