To all to whom these presents shall or may come, I bearing, know ye that I, Domingo de Guicoviria of said City for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to one in hand paid by Appleton Oaksmith of said City and other valuable consideration the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge and am therewith fully satisfied contented and paid, have this day assigned sold transferred and set over, and by these presents do for myself my heirs, administrators and executors, and also for all and every party or parties for whom I may have acted or do now act as Agent in the premises, assign sell transfer and set over unto the said Appleton Oaksmith of said City, all right title, interest or claim of whatsoever kind or nature which I or they ever had or now have (for cash advances or otherwise) in and to the cargo laden on board the Bark "Victoria" of New York as per Bill of Lading and Invoice dated Dec 18th 1854, which vessel sailed from said Port bound for St. Thomas on or about the 22nd day of December 1854 and was totally lost on or about the 6th day of January 1855; together with all right, title, interest or claim which I or they ever had or now have in and to all and every Policy or Policies of Insurance effected by said Oaksmith on said Cargo - together with all and every sum or sums of money due or to become due thereon and all benefit of whatsoever kind or nature to arise therefrom (the same to have and to hold) for the sole and individual use and benefit of the said Appleton Oaksmith, his heirs, executors administrators and assigns forever.
