

Fire at Rochester—Ice Bridge over Niagara River.

ROCHESTER, Jan. 22.

A fire occurred this morning in the rectifying house of S. M. Spencer, in this city, caused by the bursting of a still, containing sixty full barrels of high wines. The building was saved by the exertions of the firemen. Loss about \$12,000, which is covered by insurance.

The ice-bridge had formed above Niagara Falls on Sunday morning, extending three miles down the Rapids. It is the largest one for many years. People are crossing from both sides to-day.
