

## A CUBAN LEADER'S FUNERAL.

A quiet little band of sympathizers with the Cuban republican cause gathered on pier 3 North River at two o'clock yesterday afternoon to pay a last tribute of respect to the memory of Miguel de Aldama, the Cuban republican leader, whose remains rested in a plain coffin, covered simply with the American flag. The request that the Spanish flag be laid upon the bier was not complied with.

Those present included L. del Monte, Sr., and L. del Monte, Jr., son-in-law and grandson of the dead leader; T. del Calvo, T. Aviles, Ponce de Léon, T. Pinto, François Alexandre, Henri Alexandre, Captain Reynolds and First Mate Calloway, of the steamer which brought the body here.

The Rev. Father Ducey read the regular Catholic burial service. The remains will be placed in a receiving vault.
