

**DEATH OF COLONEL FRANK F. ANDERSON,**

Colonel Anderson was a native of New York, and was well known and respected by many old residents of this city for his sterling qualities as a man and for his unswerving demeanor. He was truly an adventurous life. He was with Walker in Nicaragua, and there won the rank of Colonel. During the Civil War he served in the Confederate army, and after that unhappy struggle, returned to San Francisco. A few years ago he held the position of Market Inspector, from which he was retired upon a change in the municipal administration, and leaves a widow.
