The first Masonic lodge in Savannah was organized there in 1734 by a group of Scots who had just arrived in the new colony of Georgia. The first presiding officer, called the Warden in the Scottish system then current, was Dr. Patrick Tailfer. The following year the lodge, designated only as the lodge in "Savannah in ye Province of Georgia" received its charter from the Grand Lodge of England.
