MILWAUKEE, Oct. 11 — We have advices from Kansas to the 1st inst. stating that Gov. Geary had caused to be arrested and confined in Le-compton on the charge of murder in the first degree one hundred and seven free State men, who are mostly under the charge of Col Titus.
