Kansas advices of 25th ult. state that Gov. Geary had taken measure for the recapture of the prisoners who recently escaped from Leecompton.

The Grand Jury having found bills against several pro-slavery men, a public meeting had been called, Surveyor General Calhoun presiding, at which Gov. Geary and his inquisitorial courts were repudiated and denounced, and a call issued for a law and order Convention to meet at Leavenworth, Dec. 1.

Col. Titus gives notice to all persons wishing to go to Nicaragua to rendezvous at St. Louis on Dec. 10th. A free passage is offered. He says after the settlement of the Central American question, the purpose is to turn attention to Cuba.
