

Curiosities from KANSAS.

We have just seen several curiosities—**■**umb things that speak—from KANSAS. 1. A cannon-ball (2 lbs.) made from the type of the *Herald of Freedom*--one of the kind used in the attack on 'TRUSS' fort, near Leecompton. 2. The chain with which JOHN BROWN, Jr., was manacled and bound, when driven thirty miles on a hot July day. It was rusty when put on--it is bright now, by his chafing and struggles during the time he was deranged. 3. The flag planted on the hotel and *Herald of Freedom* office at Lawrence, and under which ARCHERSON made a speech--a flag that was borne on several bloody occasions. It is a long red flag, with one "lone" star. "Southern Rights" is the motto on one side, "South Carolina" is on the other. It has been mended, where it was torn by the brick that fell from the chimney of the block, killing a man, at the attack on Lawrence.

These curiosities were brought by Mr. WHITMAN, who has just arrived in this city from the Territory, and who confirms the accounts of the sufferings and perils endured there.
