

FROM KANSAS—The correspondent of the Missouri Democrat, writing from Olathe, Kansas, Nov 25th, says

Yesterday I was in the city of Leavenworth, sometimes called the "Territorial Capital," and learned that it was the intention of Col Titus to leave with his two companies of militia for Leavenworth, and there the Governor is to disband them, for which they have petitioned, and then about one hundred will take passage for your city, there to wait until the 10th of next month, at which time they intend to embark for Niagara via New Orleans, under the command of Col Titus. He says that sufficient money has been provided to defray the expenses of the expedition. On their arrival in Central America they join the forces of "President Walker," and are expected to fight for the secure possession of that country.
