JOHN G. OWENS.

John G. Owens, a student in the graduate

school of Harvard University and holder of the Hemenway Fellowship, who died in Houduras Feb. 18, was a student in Prof. Putnam's department and was in charge of the Peabody Museum Honduras expedition. He left Cambridge last November and up to the time of his death his explorations had been very successful. He was regarded by Prof. Putnam as a promising student, and one who would soon take his place as one of the leading anthropologists in America. He was born in Lewisburg, Penn., in 1866 and graduated at Bucknell University in 1887. He would have received his doctor's

degree at Harvard next June.
