**REPORT RE**

On 9 Mar 77, the above officers and I picked up Hector Cornillot Llano from PSD, D.C. jail and went on location to identify the houses and people with whom he stayed during his 2 mos. as a fugitive from April through June of 76. We were unable to locate the first address he went to, as he arrived in Miami after dark, but we were able to ascertain its possible location to within certain limits, those being between N.W. 28th St. and 20th St. and 22nd Ave.-17th Ave. He advised that address belonged to a L/M known as "Tabacco"'s girlfriend's house. Tabacco also supplied the late model brown Monte Carlo for the escape and was involved in the escape, driving the escapees, Hector Cornillot, Gabriel Gil and Garnett Feaster to Miami. Upon arrival at the first house, Tabacco's, they spent only the first night and all made phone calls from there. Tabacco is allegedly in jail in Mexico. He is known to W. Martinez. Address and name will be identified.

The second address at which he was, 3421 N.W. 14th Avenue, with a W/F named Ronnie, who cuts hair, and a L/M known as "El Americano", already a fugitive from N.Y. (Bresser's shows that address listed to an Adonis Garcia Tel # 635-6096 - Allegedly stayed there one day.

\* The third address where he stayed was identified by him as 2580 SW 24th Ave. The fourth address was 901 E. 4th Avenue, Hialeah, where he stayed with a personal friend and also gave this address as his mailing address to people he wrote to as a fugitive. He stayed there with Ondina Comesana, or Hernandez, last name. Also stayed there four days, No Bresser's listing for address.

The fifth address was 610 N.W. 33rd Avenue. Stayed with Adam Bethencourt associate of Max Lesnick, owner of "Replica" newspaper. He states that Bethencourt will vouch for the fact he stayed there approximately eight days and that he was there on 30 Apr 76. Bresser's shows above correct with Tel #649-4407..

The sixth place was at 1569 W. 375th St. Hialeah, stayed there with Luis Volta - moved between this address and Alpha 66 office one week, returned to 1569 W. 375th St., and spent weekends at Shelbourne Hotel, Miami Beach, in between. At beach stayed with W/M Antonio Somo DeVilla a/k/a Nico Tumbadora. Finally back to Alpha 66 at 1650 N.W. 36th St. There he

sure any and all if contacted will disavow knowledge of his fugitive
