The DR is a Cuban exile, anti-CASTRO organization formed in Miami, Florida, in about August, 1971. It had about 30 members and JOSE ANTONIO CALATAYUD RIVERA is the Secretary-General of the DR. (JFIC)

MM T-1, who is closely associated with the leadership of the DR, on September 21, 1973, advised that that day JOSE ANTONIO COLMENARES ALZQUIERDO, formerly a member of the Military Section of the DR, said that RAMON FONT was the person who gave JUAN FELIPE DE LA CRUZ the explosive which CRUZ took to Spain and later to France in order to sabotage the Cuban Embassy in Paris. FLA

COLMENARES said that FONT works directly with ORLANDO BOSCH AVILA and that plans for the sabotage of the Cuban Embassy were worked out in the offices of MAX LESNIK, Director of "Replica", a Spanish language newspaper published in Miami, Florida. COLMENARES further said that LESNIK donated \$4,000 to the DR for the expenses of this mission and that the act of sabotage was planned without the knowledge of the military leaders of the DR. FLA

COLMENARES said that meetings were held by ANTONIO VECIANA, ORLANDO BOSCH, ANTONIO CALATAYUD and MAX LESNIK prior to this attempt of sabotage and these persons formulated the plans for the sabotage.

COLMENARES said that because the Military Section of the DR was not consulted he, COLMENARES, and other leading members of the other organization resigned from the DR in protest.
