

Dynamite Found On 'JFK Torch'

MIAMI. (AP) — A stick of dynamite was found Thursday on the John F. Kennedy Torch of Friendship, a frequent site for demonstrators and most recently the gathering point for Cuban exiles protesting the jailing of Felipe Rivero.

The dynamite had no blasting cap and could not have been set off, police said.

Cuban exiles gathered at the Bayfront Park site in downtown Miami earlier this week to protest the jailing of Rivero, a firebrand who claims credit for anti-Castro bombings.

The week before the eternal flame at the memorial was doused by the exile colony in a protest about the same matter.
