

# *Refugees' Meeting Dispersed*

A group of about 1,000 Cubans who gathered in Bayfront Park to pray for prisoners of Fidel Castro were ordered by police to break up when some young Cuban demonstrators appeared on the scene.

The Cubans, led in their rosary service by a priest, gathered at the Torch of Friendship last night to pray for the invasion prisoners who will be tried by the Castro government.

But some young refugees, carrying a large "save the prisoners" sign, ran against one-way traffic on Biscayne Blvd. and police dispersed the prayer meeting.
