8	was called as a witness and, having been first duly
9	sworn, was examined and testified as follows:
10	DIRECT EXAMINATION
11	BY MR. SLATER:
12	Q. Sir, my name is Andrew Slater. I'm
13	a Certified Legal Intern with the State Attorney's
14	Office.
15	What that means is that I'm a
16	third year law student. I'm not an attorney but
17	certified in the Laws of Florida to handle proceed-
18	ings such as we're about to go through today.
19	What you're here for is what's
20	called a deposition, and that's a procedure under
21	the Rules of Florida where the State or defense
22	has an opportunity to learn a little bit about the
23	other side's case.
24	You're here today because you've

	been listed as a witness for a gentleman by the
1	name of Antonio Calatayud, and I just want to find
2	out a little bit of what you know about this case.
3	Sir, would you state your name,
4	please?
5	A. Felipe Rivero.
6	Q And where do you live?
7	A. 1602 Micanopy Avenue, Coconut Grove.
8	Q And are you employed?
9	A. I am.
10	Q And how are you employed?
11	A. I'm a new car salesman, Buick.
12	Q. A new car salesman?
13	A. Yes.
14	Q Sir, do you happen to know a gentle-
15	man by the name of Antonio Calatayud?
16	A. Do I know him?
17	Q. Do you know him?
18	A. Yes, I do.
19	Q Okay. In what connection do you
20	know Mr. Calatayud?
21	A. Slightly.
22	Let me explain. By "slightly," I
23	mean, I don't socialize with him but I know him from
24	the newspapers. We've been introduced, and we have

	been together, that I remember, in one rally of
1	Cuban exiles, where he delivered a speech and I
2	delivered another one. That was, like, three years
3	ago.
4	Q. Were you present at the rally on
5	September 19, 1977, in downtown Miami?
6	A. No, I wasn't.
7	Q. Okay. Under what circumstances
8	do you know Mr. Calatayud? You said you had read
9	about him in the newspaper? What do you know of
10	him?
11	A. I know that henot much.
12	I would say that he's a man that's
13	always been, let's say, committed to this Cuban
14	problems.
15	Q What do you mean by "Cuban problems"?
16	A. Cuban problems and the fact that
17	Cuba is under Communist tyranny, and we are exiles,
18	and he's been linked to the newspapers to certain
19	activities against the Cuban government, the
20	Communist government, and on the other hand, he
21	has attended several rallies, and he's belonged to
22	anti-Castroanti-Communist organizations and Cuban
23	Communist organizations.
24	I think it was RECI, which I didn't

# belong to but he did.

1	Q So you only know Mr. Calatayud
2	through what you've read in the newspapers somewhat?
3	A. I read in the newspapers and hear-
4	say, and we've spoken three or four times, and I
5	mean that I recall three or four times, and this
6	case in 1973, when we were in the same rally.
7	Q Are you aware that there was an
8	anti-Cuban or an antiI guess, it'swould be
9	called an anti-Cuban rally in September, 1977?
10	A. Yes, I heard about it. I heard
11	about it before it occurred and before it happened,
12	and then I read in the papers a lot of hearsay,
13	and people said, you knowI didn't attend that
14	rally.
15	Q You did not attend the rally?
16	A. No.
17	Q Are you aware that Mr. Calatayud
18	was arrested at that rally?
19	A. I read it in the papers then.
20	Q Do you know any of the facts and
21	circumstances around that arrest?
22	A. If I recall correctly, he was
23	arrested because the police found a concealed weapon
24	on him.

	Q And that's all you know about that
1	day in particular?
2	A. That's all I know.
3	Q. Are you aware of any activist
4	activities against Mr. Calatayud?
5	A. Yes, I am.
6	Q Which activist activities against
7	Mr. Calatayud are you aware of?
8	A. Only one, a list of names, kind of
9	a threat that ten personsI would say two months
10	or three months maybe agoreceived by mail a
11	threatening note of ten persons, because I was one
12	of the ten persons that received the note.
13	Q. What was the substance of that
14	threatening note?
15	A. It was very
16	Let's see. Now, something like,
17	"Death to the traitor" or, "Justice will come"
18	something like that, like an Egyptian curse or
19	something like that; very childish, and then you
20	had ten names.
21	Q. You name was on the list?
22	A. My name was on the list.
23	Q And your life was threatened on
24	that letter?
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	a. It could be the work of a crackpot
1	or the heads of a little man, but nevertheless, I
2	gave it to the police and then, like, a month later
3	I received another letter, and it had a little razor
4	attached to it and a cross, where my name went,
5	and I heard from others that whoever received the
6	letter would have a little cross on it, and it said,
7	"Last warning," and I gave it to the police.
8	Q. To the best of your knowledge, was
9	Mr. Calatayud's name on that list?
10	A. Oh, yes, it was; on both.
11	Q. Are you aware of any other activities
12	aimed at either yourself or Mr. Calatayud; specifically,
13	Mr. Calatayud?
14	A. Not that I recall, no.
15	Q Had you ever heard that Mr. Calatayud's
16	home or car was bombed?
17	A. So many bombs have beenthey have
18	been so many things, I'm not sure, but I thinkI
19	can't say that. I'm not sure.
20	Q You're not sure?
21	A. I'm not sure if it was Calatayud's
22	or somebody else. It could be. It could have been
23	him, that his house was threatened or his car was
24	I'm not sure.

	Q You have no specific recollection?
1	A. I have no recollection. My memory
2	fails me.
3	Q. How long have you
4	A. Do you understand? I don't want
5	to mix any one person with another. I am very bad
6	at names.
7	Q. Well, okay.
8	How long have you known Mr. Calatayud?
9	A. Well, known him personally
10	Q. Known him personally or known of
11	his activities?
12	A. Maybe four or five years. Sporadi-
13	cally, I heard about him or seen him; for example,
14	the last time I saw him, just like a week ago at
15	the Casablanca. It's a cafeteria where a lot of
16	Cubans go, and we said, "Hello," and I think I
17	made a joke about the threatening letter and he
18	left.
19	Q. Did you know him in Cuba?
20	A. No.
21	Q. Do you have any opinion about Mr.
22	Calatayud's work or Mr. Calatayud's activity or
23	about Mr. Calatayud, himself?
24	A. Not a definite opinion. I think
