NARRATIVE:

Phone call received by Mr. E. MILIAN on Monday, 16 May 1977, at his office from convicted bomber <u>RAFAEL DE LA COVA</u>.

On 17 May 1977 at 9:30 p.m., this detective was contacted by the Communications Shift Commander and advised to contact Mr. Milian at home. Upon making contact with Mr. Milian, the following was learned from him.

That on Monday, 16 May 1977, while at his office at WOBA he had received a telephone call from convicted bomber RAFAEL DE LA COVA. Mr. DE LA COVA wanted to explain to Milian that he (DE LA COVA) had not been involved in the Grand Jury due to any information that he possessed; he further added that he had not mocked Milian as had been alleged.

DE LA COVA also stated that there were two Cubans in Miami that were communist agents and that they might be checked. The names were:

1. <u>MARTIN J. CRUZ</u> 2. <u>LAZARO SANTANA YANEZ</u>

Both subjects were known to live at 420 S. W. 12 Avenue, Miami, and are alleged to be homosexuals. No other information was provided.

Mr. Milian thought of this as curious since DE LA COVA had just testified at the Grand Jury on 13 May 1977.

Investigation continues.
