William Morgan, former American  
paratrooper and now a Major in the  
Cuban Army, who "double crossed" the  
Dominican Government in a deal in  
which Morgan was believed to have been ON  
the side of the Dominicans in an  
attempt to overthrow Castro in  
July - August, 1959.

100,000

Eloy Gutierrez Menoyo, who was  
connected with the Morgan deal.  
(NY T-1 recently read in press accounts  
relating to the Portuguese ship, SS  
"Santa Maria" that Gutierrez is one of  
the leaders of the Army of Liberation  
of Portugal and Spain).
