Our file ALL 764 246 relating to Morgan contains a copy of the Certificate of the Loss of the Nationality of the United States issued on September 3, 1959, by the United States Consul at Havana, Cuba in his case. A search of our indices has failed to disclose any record of his admission to the United States as an alien. It is noted that in an Associated Press news release of March 7, 1960, one Jack Lee Evans, who described himself as subject's bodyguard, alleged that he and the subject visited the French ship La Coubre shortly before it blew up in Havana harbor.
