

Col. Titus and his Recruits for Nicaragua.

BALTIMORE, Tuesday, Jan. 6.

Col. TITUS and his Kansas company did not arrive at New-Orleans in time to proceed to Nicaragua in the steamship *Texas*.

The *Bulletin* has the following: "The *Texas* was detained until 4 o'clock, awaiting the arrival of the *John Simonds*, on board of which are about one hundred men from St. Louis. The *Simonds* not arriving, she sailed without them. This body of one hundred men embarked at St. Louis on the steamer *Maria Denning*, for this city. Arriving at Memphis, and finding the *John Simonds* on the eve of departing for New-Orleans, they transferred themselves to her, thinking thereby to reach the city earlier than they could by the *Denning*, which has proved a great disappointment to them, as the *Denning* arrived on Saturday night.
