## Col. Titus and his Recruits for Nicaragua. BALTIMORE, TUESday, Jan. 6. Col. TITUS and his Kansas company did not arrive at New-Orleans in time to proceed to Nicaragua in the steamship Texas.

The Bulletin has the following: "The Texas was detained until 4 o'clock, awaiting the arrival of the John Simonds, on board of which are about one hundred men from St. Louis. The Simonds not arriving, she sailed without them. This body of one hundred men embarked at St. Louis on the steamer Maria Denning, for this city. Arriving at Memphis, and finding the John Simonds on the eve of departing for New Orleans, they transferred themselves to her. thinking thereby to reach the city earlier than they could by the Denning, which has proved a great disappointment to them, as the Denning arrived on Saturday night.
