A letter has been received from Grenada, Nicaragua, by a gentleman of this city, announcing the arrival, in good health, of Edmund Randolph, Esq., formerly of San Francisco — Gen. Walker, in anticipation of his arrival, had made provision for his conveyance from Virginia Bay to the Capital, and he was consequently the first of all his fellow passengers to reach the point of destination. The mission of Mr. Randolph, it is generally understood, is the drafting of a constitution and general plan of government for the new Republic. He is the intimate personal friend of Gen. Walker and has always been amongst the most ardent advocates of the expedition — *Alta.*
