Letelier, Airport Bombings Linked

New York, N.Y. —AP— Two men wanted in the bomb slaying of former Chilean Ambassador Orlando Letelier are now prime suspects in three explosions at Kennedy Airport and in New Jersey, the FBI says.

Responsibility for the new round of explosions was claimed in an anonymous telephone call to the Associated Press by Omega 7, an anti-Castro Cuban group that also claimed responsibility for a number of other explosions, including a recent one at the Cuban mission to the United Nations.

Two members of the group were sentenced to life in prison last Friday for their roles in the deaths of Letelier and a companion in the bombing of the former ambassador's car in Washington on Sept. 21, 1976. Two men still being sought in the Letelier case — Jose Dionisio Suarez and Vergilio Pablo Paz — are suspects in the Sunday night explosions, the FBI said.
