Urge FBI to trace UN mission bombers

UN Ambassador Donald F. McHenry has urged FBI Director William H. Webster to give "the highest priority" to tracking down the anti-Cuban terrorists who bombed both the Cuban and Soviet Union missions here over the past two months.

McHenry's action was disclosed late yesterday by Deputy UN Ambassador William vanden Heuvel following a private conference with Police Commissioner Robert McGuire at Police Headquarters. McGuire had

requested the meeting with Vanden Heuvel to discuss "greater cooperation" between city and federal agencies in protecting the foreign diplomatic missions in the city.

Also discussed was what can be done to better investigate such groups as Omega 7, an anti-Castro group that claimed credit for the two Cuban Mission bombings on Dec. 7 and Oct. 27 and Tuesday night's bombing at the Soviet UN Mission.
