Bomb Explodes at Mission Of Cuba in Washington

WASHINGTON, May 19 (AP) — A bomb exploded last night behind the three-story building that houses the Cuban mission here, the police said, breaking windows in nearby buildings but causing no injuries.

A man telephoned The Associated Press later, saying he belonged to a group called Omega 7 and that it was responsible for the bombing. He said, "We demand the withdrawal of Cuban troops on the African continent."

The police said two men were seen running down the street near the building, officially known as the Cuban Interest Section of the Czechoslovak Embassy, shortly after the explosion at 11:48 P.M.
