

HORRIBLE OUTRAGE AND MURDER BY A NEGRO—The Murderer Burned. On Tuesday last, a negro man belonging to Mr. Hardy Kiel, residing in Wilkinson county, violated the persons of, and afterwards murdered his mistress and her sister, Mrs. Mason, whilst they were washing at a spring near the house. He then stole a horse, and attempted to escape, but was so closely pursued by some of Mr. Kiel's neighbors, that he had to leave the horse and take the river swamp. Several citizens of the county turned out to search for the murderer, and succeeded in arresting him at 11 o'clock, Tuesday night. They then tied him to a stake and burned him to death.—Savannah (Ga.) Georgian, August 4.
