**TRIAL OF THE SOLOMON NORTHER KIDNAPERS**—The trial of the Solomon Northup Kidnappers was expected to come off yesterday before Judge Beecher, at Balston. W. A. Beach, C. B. Cochran, and Wm. Wait, appeared for the prisoners, and moved to quash some of the counts in the indictment, alleging that the sale took place in the District of Columbia, and consequently no jurisdiction could be had. After a long argument by Messrs. Cochran and Beach for the prisoners, and District attorney Odell for the people, the Court advised them to go up to a full bench on a demurrer to the indictment.
