

## **Trial of the Suspected Kidnappers of Solomon Northrup.**

SARATOGA, Tuesday, July 11.

The examination of ALEXANDER MERRILL and JOSEPH RUSSELL, charged with kidnapping SOLOMON NORTHROP and selling him into Slavery, has been in progress to-day at Ballston, Spa. NORTHROP distinctly swears to their being the persons,—and told how he was hired at Saratoga Springs in 1841, to go South with them to join a Circus, and treated in Washington with drugged liquor, &c., &c. A witness was in Court who drank with NORTHROP and his kidnappers at Washington, the night before he was put in the Slave pen,—and it is expected that a witness will come forward and testify to having heard MERRILL tell of selling NORTHROP

The accused were discovered from the descriptions and incidents given in NORTHROP's book.
