

3 Terrorists in Uruguay Die in Battles With Police

MONTEVIDEO, Uruguay, May 31 (Reuters)—Three terrorists were killed and a number were captured during gun battles with security forces early today as authorities pressed a hunt for guerrillas who raided a navy training center two days ago, official sources said.

About 50 members of the Tupamaros movement, a left-wing urban guerrilla organization, raided the training center in the port area here on Friday and escaped with a truckload of arms, including 300 rifles, ammunition and tear gas. Several in the group were dressed in navy uniforms and overpowered the guards.

One terrorist was killed this morning during a search by security forces in Chacras, 13 miles from here. It was believed that shooting started when the police tried to search a house.

Two other guerrillas were reported to have been killed and several captured during a gunfight in a Montevideo suburb.
