Affairs in Cuba-Excitement and Exaggerated Reports-The Resolution at Clenfueges-Preparations of the Government, &c.

HAVANA, February 8 - A band of insurgents. whose members are naknown, have made their appearance at the town of Cameron, and on the line of the railroad between Cienfuegos and Vi-la Clara. A detachment of troops have marched against them. A panic prevails in Clenfuegos. Many families have fled from the town, fearing insurrection will spread to that district, and have arrived in this city. Fort Sabanos, which guards the place, is garrisoued only by a battalion of volunteers, and a force of regulars has been dispatched to reinforce them. The Diario. in its account of the outbreak at Camaron, states that the first act of the rebels will be to destroy the section of railway between Clenfuegue and Villa Ciara.

The same paper acknowledges that the situation in this quarter is very grave. Much excitement has been created in Havana by versions, more or less exaggerated, of events in the contral department. The approach of the revolution to the vicinity of ticnfaeges, which is the centre of a large planting district, is expected

to cause a rise la the sugar market."

Several attempts at revolution have been made in the Vueta Abajo region, and the first and fifth battalions of volunteers are under orders to proceed to that point to prevent a renewal of disorder. Strangers continue to arrive at various points on the coast, it is supposed with the intention of joining the revolutionists. Many have

The government has chartered several atcomers and is preparing some men of war and lightdraft steam lannches to sall to Roman Keys and prevent the expected disembarkation of an expedition from Nassau, and when that is accompitated the folils will proceed to attack the earthworks which the insurgents frave exected at

Leguanaia.

Rebels recently assembled at Managua to the number of three handred. They were attacked by troops, and, according to the official report, were defeated, losing all their arms, automate tion and eleven prisoners.
