### Revolutionary Congress in Cuba— Annexation Resolutions, &c.

HAVANA, April 30, via New York, May 3.—The revolutionary party held a grand Congress at Sabidosa on the 13th of April. Cespedes presided, and thirty representatives were present from all parts of the island. Resolutions declaring that the revolutionary party were fighting for independence from Spain and annexation to the United States were unanimously adopted.—Quezada was again elected generalissimo of the revolutionary armies. The delegates were enthusiastic, sanguine and determined.

From Puerto Principe a report comes that the Spanish troops have captured Betancourt and several other members of the revolutionary committee.

HAVANA, May 3.—The journals announce that the insurgents appeared in the jurisdiction of Ciego de Avila and the surrounding country. Many large plantations and estates have been seized in the country by the government officials under the confiscation decree.
