NEWS FROM CUBA.

WASHINGTON, May 10.—The government to-day received advices direct from the insurrectionary portion of Cuba, giving information as to the movements in that quarter. Parties here in the interest of the Cubans state that there are now in the Cuban army 25,000 men, 2500 of whom are Americans, and that about 8000 of the latter nationality have recently been added to the number. It is said by the representatives of the revolutionary army of Cuba in Washington that success would be placed beyond a doubt if the United States would recognize the belligerent rights of those who are striving to effect the independence of Cuba, and, in that case, the men and money already promised would be furnished in abundance.
