THE CUBAN REVOLUTION.

Cuban sympathizers here say there are two

armies on the Island in their interest,—the one which is in the eastern part, commanded by General Jourdan, late of our rebel army, who has 22,000 men, and the other in the western part, commanded by General Quesada, who has 20,-000 men. About half the entire force are liberated slaves, about 18,000 are Cubans, while the rest are American and Spanish deserters. The Cubans say they are not trying to do much now, but will enter on an active campaign about the first of October.
